2016 Swimming Pool Season

It will soon be swimming pool season! The pool will be open 7 days a week from 1 to 5 and 6 to 8pm. Look in the Leader-Courier, City website, and Channel 98 on Cable TV for more information when the pool officially opens. Swimming lessons have been scheduled for June 20-30, July 11-21, and August 1-11, 2016. You can pickup up swimming lesson registration forms at City Hall. The following are the pool fees:

- Family Season Pass: \$95.00
- Single (Adult or Child) Season Pass: \$60.00
- Punch Pass: \$40.00
- Adult Daily Admission: \$2.50
- Child Daily Admission: \$1.50
- Swim Lessons: \$30.00
- Pool Party for 2-60 people: \$100.00
- Pool Party for over 60 people: \$150.00
- Wading Pool: No fee.

Spring Cleanup

The City will sponsor a Spring Cleanup for May 21 and 22, 2016 at the City Rubble Site from 9am to 5pm. Stop at City Hall to pickup certificate (limited to one per household) prior to going to the Landfill.

Recycling Center

Located east of the water treatment plant, corner of Main & Jackson Streets. Open every Monday & Thursday, 5:00pm to 7:00pm.

Utility Billing

Clarification, utility bill is due upon receipt of the bill and is considered delinquent the 5th of the month.

Off Street Parking

(City Ordinance No. 367, Section 11:04)

All travel trailers, trailers and recreational vehicles shall be parked or stored behind the Right-Of-Way when they are to remain stationary. Travel trailers, trailers, and recreational vehicles which are to remain stationary shall be owned by the owner/occupant of the property and shall not serve as temporary or permanent sleeping quarters for any person for more than seven (7) days within a thirty (30) consecutive day period.



Storm Shelters

If we are under a severe weather or tornado warning, Elk Point does have designated storm shelters for your protection. Call the Elk Point Police Department at (605) 356-2184 and they will direct you to the nearest shelter.

## **Keep Our Community Beautiful!**

Friendly reminder that all property owners are required to cut and keep control at all times during the growing season all weeds, noxious weeds, grass and noxious vegetation. When walking your dog please bring plastic bags with you and clean after their messes. Remember, people like to walk along the walking paths, parks, pool area and ball parks free from stepping into dog feces. City Ordinance 347, Section 5.0216, paragraph C states, "It shall be the duty of every person owning or having the custody or control of an animal to clean up, remove and dispose of the feces deposited by such animal upon public property, park property, public right-of way or the property of another."
