

The City of Elk Point Swimming Pool Rules

As a result of COVID-19 we need special guidelines and regulation to keep staff and patrons of the pool safe.

- 1. Anyone ill or experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 will not be able to utilize the pool and its facilities until fully recovered. It is the responsibility of the patrons to be accountable and stay safe.
- 2. We will **NOT** be providing swimming lessons this summer to better prevent the spread of COVID-19.
- 3. The Elk Point pool will only be available to Elk Point citizens or families of the EPJ school district.
- 4. You MUST purchase a pool pass at the Elk Point Swimming Pool. You must present proof of residency or EPJ enrollment to purchase a pool pass. The City will provide you with your entry pass to the pool.
- 5. Seasons Passes will be \$95.00 per family and \$60.00 for single individual.
- 6. We will not be providing deck chairs for patrons to utilize throughout the day. Lawn chairs, towels and blankets are welcome, no food or coolers.
- 7. Our hours will be 1:00 pm 6 pm. Pool Capacity will be limited to 100 in main pool and 20 in baby pool. Pool Parties can be scheduled through City Hall, cost \$100.00 2-60 people \$150.00 60-100 people, rule 3 applies and it will depend upon lifeguard availability.
- 8. We will have concessions, but only prepackaged food and drinks will be sold. Hand sanitizer will be located at concession stand.
- 9. Changing rooms and portable restrooms will be opened and cleaned throughout the day.
- 10. We will not allow pool toys, or balls in the pool. You can bring your own life jackets.
