The DAK-12 Conference meet took place Wednesday, Oct. 9. It was moved from the planned date of Oct. 10 due to impending winter weather.

The competition was intense, with runners from Lennox, Sioux Falls Christy Tea Area, Tri-Valley, Madison, West Central, Dell Rapids, Vermillion, Dakota Valley, Canton and Elk Point-Jefferson.

The Huskies placed three in the medals. Casey Kneip was 17th in the boys varsity, Heather Stark was 16th in girls varsity, with Ashley Stark 19th. Overall, the girls placed 5th in the team scoring.

The region meet is Thursday, Oct. 17 in Beresford, with the state championships Oct. 26 at Huron.

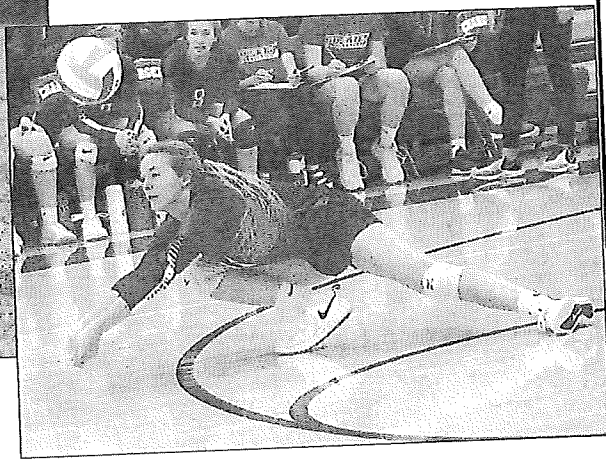
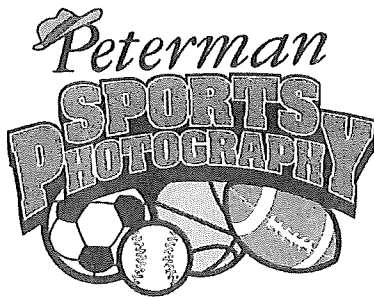

Attention Rubble Site Users

The City of Elk Point would like to remind citizens to read the big yellow sign at the entrance of the rubble site and follow what can and cannot be dumped.

Metal Pile – NO couches, recliners, mattresses, upholstered furniture, items with lots of plastic or wood attached to the metal. Just because there is metal in the item doesn't mean it belongs there. "White Goods" means dishwashers, washing machines and dryers. Not toilets or porcelain sinks.

Grass & Leaves pile – No plastic bags. Sticks should be taken to the tree pile, not dropped in with grass clippings. Citizens can use biodegradable brown paper grass and leaf bags.

Scrap lumber – No asphalt shingles, insulation, green treated wood, plastic, plastic bags, Styrofoam, sheetrock, cardboard or tires. Please take metal hinges and knobs off doors.

Tree pile – No plastic bags, buckets, treated wood, grass clippings, leaves, couches or chairs.

The EPA and SD DENR have very strict rules on what can and cannot be dumped.

If you are caught dumping anything unauthorized, you will be fined \$500.
